Course Information

The updated course was the first 27 hole facility in the Western Cape and provides plenty of challenge and interest for golfers of every ability. Some holes meander along the Berg River while many are tree-lined lush green channels which present the golfer with an enticing mix of risk and reward. Others feature spectacular mountain backdrops and glorious views across the valley. Water hazards provide an active and challenging feature, while colorful gardens border many of the holes.

The Club has hosted some of South Africa's **Sunshine Tour Events** with great success, as well as the 2007 South African amateur championship. The Club provides a home for many local, regional and national corporate golf days, which draws great praise for the quality of the experience provided and the friendliness and efficiency of staff. It hosts a large list of annual events, culminating in the annual Paarl Golf Club festival which has been run since 1979.

Golf Cart R280 per cart

Only 35 carts available. Carts need to be pre-booked. For fields bigger than 70 players, it is encouraged to take a cart and a caddy.

Caddies R220 per caddy

Please confirm before the day if caddies are required so that we can arrange.

Pull Trolley R75 per trolley

Only 35 carts available. Carts need to be pre-booked. For fields bigger than 70 players, it is encouraged to take a cart and a caddy.

Rental Sets R420 per set

DEPOSIT/CANCELLATION

A non-refundable deposit of R5 000 (R2 500 for non-profit organizations & schools) is required to secure your booking. Any golf days cancelled within 7 days of the event will be charged in full. Please refer to the booking contract for full cancellation conditions.



GOLF CONDITIONS

Registration and Recording of Scores

The Club will be happy to collect scores and tabulate results for clients. In this case, organizers are asked to:

- Make it clear to each person/player what the golf day format is.
- Make sure that their score cards will be filled in correctly.
- Make sure that the player knows where to write the final score on the score card.
- Ensure that names are written clearly on the score cards.
- Ask competitors to hand their score cards into Registration immediately after the completion of their rounds.

All players must report to the registration table at least 30 minutes before tee off time.

Shotgun Starts – only by prior arrangement.

Tee off times have 8 minute intervals.

Please note that each 9 holes must be completed in 2 hours & 15 minutes to ensure that all golfers have an enjoyable round of golf.

Tee off times in summer start at 11:30 and during winter at 10:30.

The use of carts is strictly controlled. Golfers are expected to obey all cart rules.

Boschenmeer has the right to cancel the use of carts on any particular day due to course conditions.

It is compulsory to have a filled sandbag and it is expected that the golfer will fill in every divot on the fairways and tees.

All pitch marks must be repaired.

Halfway is strictly Grab & Go.



GOLF CONDITIONS (continued)

Shop

Our resident PGA Professionals have a well-stocked shop and will be delighted to provide prizes, clothing, golf balls and equipment and other services, including golf clinics, by prior arrangement.

Code (Guidelines in terms of dress code in and around the Clubhouse)

Men

Golf shirts with collar and sleeves & 'Tiger' shirts (mock polo).
Tailored trousers & tailored shorts (no rugby / soccer / gym or beach short types).
Ladies : Standard golf attire – slacks / skirts / skorts / capri's and golf shirts / blouses / tops.
Soft spikes only

Clubhouse / After Golf

Smart casual clothing at all times – includes smart denim jeans (not torn / faded), but no shorts.
Footwear: We do not allow beach thongs, slip slops, crocs. No bare feet.
No sleeveless t-shirts, gym wear, beach wear etc.
Remove caps / hats in Clubhouse.

Boschenmeer Golf Estate reserves the right to deny access to the Clubhouse if regulations are not adhered to.



SPONSOR / BRANDING / WATERING HOLE CONDITIONS

Sponsor & Branding Conditions

All branding must reach Boschenmeer Golf Estate no later than 08:30 the day of the event and be taken to the Events Coordinator.

You will be advised where and how to install your branding.

Awareness of golf etiquette is important when a sponsor mans a hole.

All sponsors must ensure that tees are clean when they leave the golf course.

Boschenmeer Golf Estate will not take responsibility for any loss or damage arising out of or connected to the erecting of promotional material, notwithstanding that every effort will be made to avoid damages or loss.

All branding/décor items need to be removed on the day of the function unless specific arrangements have been made. Any items not removed within 7 days after the function will be discarded. The Club does not accept liability or loss of items during this period.

Please indicate well in advance whether Pin Flags need to be set up.

Watering Hole Conditions

All food & beverage arrangements must be approved well in advance and purchased from Boschenmeer. A maximum of 4 wet holes is allowed.

- Food & beverage may only be supplied by yourself if it is on a 1:1 basis or if you pay the whole corkage fee of R100 (alcohol rules still apply). In other words, if you supply 3 cases of beer, 3 cases must be given to the Club.
- We discourage large amounts of alcohol on the course. Beer & hard liquor are allowed at Halfway, before or after golf. On course, we allow shooters and tastings of alcoholic products.

Sponsors must supply their own equipment, eg tables, chairs & umbrellas.

Ice is limited on golf days. Please arrange and order well in advance.

Representatives of your company or the sponsor must be stationed at the wet holes to man them.



FUNCTION CONDITIONS

We ask that all golfers and guests please behave respectfully & courteously at all times.

Please keep noise levels down outside the Clubhouse building as we have a number of homeowners living in close proximity to the Clubhouse.

Smoking is only permitted on the terraces.

All food & beverages must be supplied by Boschenmeer.

Last rounds at the bar will be called at 22:00 and the venue should be vacated by midnight.

Extra charges apply should the venue be used after midnight.

The organizing Events Coordinator is to remain until all guests leave.

Boschenmeer Golf Estate reserves the right to limit alcohol to guests seemingly under the influence for their own safety.

The Winelands venue is charged at no cost and is equipped with a screen, microphone & sound. Any extra AV requirements need to be arranged by the event organizer.
